

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MARKING YOUR BALLOT

FOR RANKED CHOICE VOTING:

- Mark only one choice per column.
- Do not skip columns.
- Rank as many or as few candidates as you would like.
- Select your 1st choice candidate and fill in the oval next to that candidate's name in the 1st choice column. If you have a 2nd choice candidate, fill in the oval next to that candidate's name in the 2nd choice column, and so on.
- You do **not** have to rank all the candidates – your ballot will be counted even if you only rank one candidate for an office.
