RESIDENT WINTER SAND POLICY

Purpose: This policy outlines the availability and intended use of the Town of Buckfield's resident winter sand supply.

Availability: Resident winter sand will be available outside the entrance gate at the Public Works Facility on John Ellingwood Road beginning in mid-November until the winter subsides. No sand is available to residents inside the gates of the Public Works Facility.


Use: The resident sand pile is for the express use of the residents of Buckfield. Resident sand is for private non-commercial use only, and is limited to two 5-gallon pails per household per storm. Resident sand is for use on walkways and steps and it is not the intention of the Town to provide salted sand for the purpose of sanding driveways.

Controls: The resident sand pile will be monitored by the Public Works Foreman during normal working hours. The resident sand pile will be refilled by the Public Works Department based on their availability. The Select Board may suspend the resident sand program based on weather and economic conditions as necessary.


Enactment: This Policy is enacted this 20th day of November, 2018.
